Meow's unique brand of kamikaze cabaret kitsch and performance art exotica has hypnotised audiences worldwide and taken her from New York to Shanghai, Berlin to Edinburgh. There's not a city in the world that's not head over heels in love with this fabulous feline.

Beyond Glamour, Meow's solo show, sold out fast last time she visited Brisbane Powerhouse in 2007 and was also chosen by David Bowie for his High Line Festival in New York, "incited" by director John Cameron Mitchell (creator of *Shortbus* and *Hedwig and the Angry Inch*).

This is Meow Meow stripped bare (figuratively speaking of course, although you never know your luck) and close enough that you can touch her (literally, we're sure she'll love it).

Meow's collaborators include a who's who of music, cabaret, performance art and theatre; from Justin Bond, Taylor Mac and Penny Arcade to The Dresden Dolls, Iain Grandage and the legendary Mikhail Baryshnikov.

For these special Brisbane Powerhouse shows, Meow will be performing with pianist and composer, John Thorn who won the 2005 Green Room Award for musical direction for Mark Trevorrow, *IT'S ABOUT TIME* and who has another five Green Room Award nominations to his bow along with numerous theatre, screen and musical credits.
