



## Belgium Just Can't Ghent Enough of Brisbane's Topology

Brisbane Powerhouse's ensemble-in-residence tour internationally

The Ghent Festival of Flanders, an international music festival held annually in Belgium, will host Brisbane-grown Aussie talent when inventive multi-genre band Topology brings their critically acclaimed works *Difference Engine* and *Ten Hands* to the festival on Friday 7 October.

Topology's Robert Davidson says "it's Europe's biggest festival, so we're pretty excited. When the festival's Artistic Director Jelle Dierickx heard one of our Sydney concerts last year he booked us on the spot. I think he liked the cheekiness of some of our music, which he said was very Australian and fresh".

Topology is Brisbane Powerhouse's ensemble-in-residence and the band features John Babbage, Robert Davidson, Kylie Davidson, Bernard Hoey, Christa Powell and Therese Milanovic. The band have worked closely with a wide range of artists including Geoffrey Rush, The Brodsky Quartet, The Kransky Sisters, Katie Noonan, Kate Miller-Heidke, Grant Collins, the Queensland Ballet and Expressions Dance Company amongst many more.

Brisbane audiences can check out Topology when they perform with Loops (Melbourne) on Sunday 2 October where they bring their show *Airwaves* back to the Visy Theatre – An inventive musical tapestry of the most iconic radio speeches of the 20th century. Famous voices are accompanied with live music that emphasises their inherent melodies, so that we hear what sounds like singing from Gandhi, Clinton, Churchill, Whitlam, MLK, George VI and a century's worth of others.
